<u>Additional School Standards Grant (SSG) Funding</u>

• The Chancellor's Budget statement 2006 delivered on the 22nd March announced there would be new funding for schools to help make a faster headstart on delivering personalisation. Additional funds in 2006/07 and in 2007/08 will be paid direct to schools through the SSG to help them provide greater personalisation of learning in and beyond the school day, especially for children from disadvantaged backgrounds. The new money is not ring-fenced. For 2006/07 the extra funding will be made available during September 2006.

The DfES criteria for allocations is based on the following:

- Unweighted pupil numbers (pupils aged 5yrs -15yrs at January 2006);
- Free School Meals (pupils aged 5yrs -15yrs at January 2006);
- Low prior attainment (KS1 Reading Writing or Maths below level 2, and KS2 English or Maths below level 4).

Deprivation Funding Review – DfES

• The DfES has now published the outcomes from the deprivation review earlier this year. www.teachernet.gov.uk lists the local authority statements, the technical review of deprivation indicators together with contextual attainment data. LAs and School Forums will be asked to undertake a full review of local arrangements to consider the extent to which their own arrangements deliver resources to schools in a way that best supports schools to close the gap in pupil outcomes. Any formula changes will be effective from April 2008.

Falling Pupil Numbers

- The table below highlights the fall in confirmed pupil numbers used to calculate the Dedicated Schools Grant between 2005 and 2006.
- The loss of 715 pupils equates to reduction in funding for Dudley of £2.5m for 2006/07.

<u>Dedicated Schools Grant – 2006/07 Final Allocation</u>

- As a result of the fall in pupil numbers particularly in Early Years, compared to initial estimates, the final Dedicated Schools Grant has been confirmed as £173.955m, some £489k less than originally estimated. This was reported to Schools Forum on 11th July when the following decisions were taken:
 - 1. £200k originally allocated to fund Early Years growth will be retained to offset against the £489k deficit in 2006/07;
 - 2. The remaining £289k deficit will be carried forward to offset against 2007/08 Dedicated Schools Grant; this includes the one off planned allocations of £250k to the full service extended schools.

Section 52 2006/07 Budget Statement reissued for DSG change Table 1 only.

 As a result of the revision to the DSG, Table 1 of the Section 52 Budget Statement was amended and re-submitted to the DfES in July 2006. The changes are not significant.

Clawback of Reserves

 Overall school balances have risen again. The Director has received satisfactory statements of intent from all schools with excessive budget carry-forward. Following minor changes to the LMS scheme for 2007/08 the exercise will be repeated in 2007 to ensure that excessive balances have been reduced as planned.

2007/08 and Later Years Budget

- School indicative budgets for 2007/08 will be issued in February 2007.
- The DfES will release financial budget data for the multi-year period 2008-2011 during the Autumn 2007 Comprehensive Spending Review (CSR).
- The DfES has announced that they will issue a consultation paper in Spring 2007 in respect of the current funding process including the DSG.
