

1. Friends of Homer Hill Park

An application has been received from the group for capital funding of up to £3,350 towards the total cost of installing two metal bench and table sets with disability access overhang into a new children's lay area in Homer Hill Park, Cradley. They will be on a tarmac base adjoining a tarmac perimeter path. The total cost of the project would be £3,850. The remaining £500 would be met from fund raising by the group.

2. Members may recall a grant of £634 which was approved in 2008/09 towards the purchase of a colour printer/copier.

3. *I am recommending that members consider whether a grant of up to £3,350 should be approved.*
