Decline in Bus Patronage and Use of Concessionary Passes - Reference from Former Select Committee on Economic Regeneration

Purpose of Report

1. To consider a reference from the former Select Committee on Economic Regeneration regarding the issue of a decline in bus patronage and use of concessionary passes.

Background

- 2. The former Select Committee on Economic Regeneration at its meeting held on 16th February, 2006, considered a report of the Director of the Urban Environment on usage of bus passes and bus patronage, attached as Appendix A to this report, and in noting the content of the report and supporting the remaining recommendations contained in that report also resolved :-
 - (4) "That the issue of a decline in bus patronage and use of concessionary passes be referred to the Select Committee on the Environment for investigation".
