Supplementary Report of the Area Liaison Officer

Request for Capital Funding – Halesowen Town Centre – Christmas Lights

- 1. A request from the Halesowen Chamber of Trade to provide funding for the purchase of additional Christmas lights for Halesowen Town Centre has recently been received.
- 2. Given the impact of the development work, the Chamber would like to increase the number of sets of lights in seven trees in the Town Centre and also provide a bespoke entrance crossing display across the High Street. It is felt this would make a strong message to passing traffic. The total cost would be about £5,100 and the Chamber has requested a grant of £5,000.
- 3. The Area Committee has previously approved grant, totalling £9,500 for the purchase of lights. The total cost of erecting, maintaining and running the Christmas lights is approximately £8,000 - £10,000 and this is met from a contribution from the Council's Town Centre Management Capital Budget and contributions from local businesses.
- 4. Additional Christmas lighting will increase the attractiveness of the Town Centre and particularly given the impact that the development work will have over the Christmas period, I am recommending the Committee approves a grant of £5,000 for 2007/08.

Recommendation

5. This is an application which meets the funding criteria and I am recommending that the Committee approves an allocation of £5,000 for which there is provision in the budget.

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
