



PUBLIC NOTICE

Consumption of Alcohol in Stourbridge Bus Station and The Old Quarter Stourbridge

Under Section 13 of the Criminal Justice and Police Act 2001, Dudley Metropolitan Borough Council has made an Order designating Stourbridge Bus Station and the Old Quarter Stourbridge as an area where the public consumption of alcohol is prohibited other than within licensed premises or registered clubs. This order will come into effect on the

The area designated by the Order is bounded by and includes South Road, The Playing Field abutting Charles Road/Swan Street, Bowling Green Road Mamble Road, Enville Street, Bridgnorth Road to junction with King Street, Worcester Street, Stourbridge.

When this order comes into effect on the it will be an offence for any person to fail to comply with a requirement by a Police Constable not to drink alcohol in public within the area designated by the order or to fail to surrender such alcohol.
