### **Recycling Working Group**

### Purpose of Report

1. To approve a Work Programme for 2009/10 for the Recycling Working Group.

### **Background**

- 2. At the meeting of this Working Group held on 7<sup>th</sup> September, 2009, consideration was given to the following Work Programme for 2009/10:
  - a. A report and presentation on community initiatives to minimise waste including freecycle;
  - b. A site visit to Dorset or Humberside to examine best practice in new household waste recycling and disposal sites and report to a subsequent meeting;
  - c. A site visit to observe the development of the proposed new facility at the site at Blowers Green with a presentation at a future meeting together with a site visit to examine the Lister Road Waste to Energy Plant in operation, a tour of the depot and a presentation;
  - d. Report and presentation on recycling participation rates throughout the Borough;
