# **Co-opted Member**

# **Purpose of Report**

1. To consider the appointment of a co-opted member to represent Local Tenants and Residents for 2008/9.

# **Background**

- 2. At its meeting on the 16<sup>th</sup> June 2008 the Committee deferred appointing a coopted member to represent Local Tenants and Residents pending a nomination from the Stourbridge Area Forum.
- 3. In September 2008 I received confirmation that the Stourbridge Area Forum had again nominated Ms P Shepherd who has been a co-opted member for several years.
- 4. Members are reminded that the Protocol for Area Committees permits the Area Committee to co-opt up to five persons on to the Committee for the period expiring with the conclusion of a municipal year. Co-opted members are entitled to speak at meetings but not to vote.
- 5. The Protocol requires that the Area Committee, in appointing co-opted members, must have due regard to the extent to which persons to be co-opted represent interest of importance within the communities served by the Committee. There is a further requirement that co-optees shall not represent the views of any political party on the Committee. Furthermore, the Committee has previously decided that co-optees must not be employed by the Council or be members of a political party.

#### **Finance**

6. Co-opted members are entitled to receive travelling and subsistence allowances in accordance with Section 174 of the Local Government Act 1972 and a Financial Loss Allowance in accordance with Section 173(4) of that Act.

## Law

7. Section 102(3) of the Local Government Act 1972, enables the Committee to appoint co-opted members.

# **Equality Impact**

8. This report complies fully with the Council's policies on equality and diversity.

# **Recommendation**

9. It is recommended that the Area Committee consider the appointment of Ms P Shepherd as a co-opted member to represent Local Tenants and Residents.
