In my view this is not a self contained unit and putting signs around the vehicle would cause both a trip hazard and an eyesore in the town centre. In addition, looking at the photos there would be a risk to members of the public while the cutting of keys was being carried out I cannot see any safety barriers to stop children climbing in the vehicle or to stop them interfering with the table where the keys are cut. Mr Somerville does not indicate where the power supply comes from to operate the machine - which would be another cause for concern. There are sufficient numbers of Street Traders in the Market Place and there is a key cutting service in Spencers Market in the Market Place and in the Fountain Arcade.
