Members' Planning Code of Good Practice

Purpose of Report

1. To consider amendments to the Members' Planning Code of Good Practice.

Background

- 2. At its meeting on the 24th July 2006 the Council approved a recommendation of the Standards Committee with regard to the adoption of the Members' Planning Code of Good Practice.
- 3. As a result of the new Members' Code of Conduct approved in July 2007 a number of consequential amendments to the Planning Code of Good Practice are required. A copy of the Planning Code of Good Practice indicating the consequential amendments is attached at Appendix 1. The revised draft also includes a number of changes recommended by officers by way of clarification or to emphasise the importance of a particular issue.
- 4. At its meeting on the 14th January 2008 the Standards Committee recommended approval of the revised draft subject to any comments made by the Development Control Committee.
- 5. A final decision on the revised draft will be taken by the Council at its meeting on the 25th February 2008.

Law


