- 2.2 In response to a query regarding the safety of the derelict toilet block in King George VI Park in Wordsley and information regarding the opening and closing of the Park, the Director of the Urban Environment has written advising the name of the new contractors employed to open and close the Park, and the current situation with regard to the demolition of the toilet block.
- 2.3 In response to a query regarding the number of trees in Leys Crescent damaging property and “leaf fall” causing a hazard to pedestrians, the Director of the Urban Environment has written advising on the current situation with regard to these issues.
