REPORT OF THE AREA LIAISON OFFICER

CAPITAL ALLOCATIONS

1.0 Summary of Deferred Applications by Ward

ST JAMES'S WARD

1.1 Victim Support (Witness Service)

The recommendation is that this organization be awarded a capital grant of **£1,400.00** to purchase new furniture for the Court witness rooms and a laser printer for the office.

ST THOMAS'S WARD

1.2 Hellier Street Youth & Community Association

The recommendation is that this association be awarded a capital grant of **£1887.00** to purchase office furniture and equipment.

2.0 Summary of New Applications by Ward

CASTLE & PRIORY WARD

2.1 Dudley Sea Cadets

The recommendation is that this group be awarded a capital grant of **£3978.55** to enable the outside of their building to be re-rendered.

NETHERTON, WOODSIDE & ST ANDREWS WARD

2.2 Primrose Hill Congregational Church

The recommendation is that this church hall be awarded a capital grant of **£2,642.00** to contribute towards the cost of new kitchen equipment and the associated fitting.

Note: This amount has been reduced proportionately from the original sum considered because of the lack of funds currently available within the Ward.

2.3 Luncheon Club at St Augustine's

The recommendation is that this club be awarded a capital grant of **£1,000.00** to purchase dining chairs and small tables.

2.4 Ar- Rahman Care Trust (Dudley)

The recommendation is that this trust be awarded a capital grant of **£2,158.00** to purchase office furniture and computer equipment.

Note: This amount has been reduced proportionately from the original amount considered, because of the lack of funds currently available within the Ward.

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QUARRY BANK & DUDLEY WOOD WARD

2.5 Friends of Stevens Park

The recommendation is that this group be awarded a capital grant of **£1,000.00** to purchase wrought iron handrails for the steps to the memorial garden within the park. If approved, the work will be carried out under the control of Dudley Property Consultancy.

ST JAMES'S WARD

2.6 Impact Training

The recommendation is that this organization be awarded a capital grant of **£998.00** to purchase new replacement carpeting.

It is also recommended that:

- Their application for a grant to install disabled toilets be deferred to the next meeting of the Working Group, to enable further information to be obtained.
- Their application for security shutters be refused because the Ward wishes to concentrate its limited funds on the stated health and safety issues within this organization.
