# Black Country Review of Health Services - Consultation.

### **Purpose of Report**

 To invite members to comment upon and make decisions as appropriate in relation to the proposals contained in the Black Country Review Consultation Document.

#### **Background**

- 2. A review of health services in the Black Country has been taking place since 2003. Members of the Committee have seen and commented upon the full report at earlier Committees. The aim of the review is to consider how best to meet the long term health needs of people in Dudley, Walsall and Wolverhampton.
- The proposed changes at this stage concern Cancer services, Cardiac services, Paediatric and Neonatal services at Russells Hall Hospital, The Manor Hospital, and New Cross Hospital.
