- (2) That the Director of Corporate Resources, in consultation with the Cabinet Member for Personnel, Legal and Property, be authorised to determine all applications for voluntary redundancy including those where there are pension implications, up to a maximum of £6.5m for direct redundancy costs and £2.5m for the capitalised cost of pension strain.

The decisions will come into force, and may then be implemented, on the expiry of five working days of 19th May, 2011, unless a Select Committee objects to a decision and calls it in.
