## Report of the Director of Children's Services

## Looked After Children Results

## Purpose of Report

1. The purpose of this report is to inform the Committee about the test results for Looked After Children (LAC).

#### **Background**

 Since November 2007 Dudley has been supporting Looked After Children with a private tutor / mentor programme. This project has been funded by The Creating Chances Charity and Dudley MBC. In the past 12 months – 300 Looked After Children have been supported on a one to one basis. The impact of this project is evidenced in the key stage outcomes outlined below:-

## • English Key Stage 2 Results

Provisional results for 2010 are 46% level 2 or above which is an increase of 8.6% from last year.

#### • Mathematics Key Sage 2 Results

Provisional results for 2010 are 33.3% level 2 or above which is a fall of 7.3% from last year.

- 3. In 2009 <u>**7%**</u> of Dudley Looked After Children achieved 5 A\* C GCSE's including Maths and English. The National average is 13%.
- 4. In 2010 <u>25%</u> of Dudley Looked After Children achieved 5 A\* C GCSE's including Maths and English which is a rise of 18% and is now 12% above the national average.
- 5. Of those Year 11 pupils who took GCSE's, there were a number who received Private Tuition from the Dudley project which has now been running for 3 years. 39% of those year 11 Looked After Children who received private tuition gained 5 A\* C including Maths and English.
