REPORT OF THE DIRECTOR OF LAW AND PROPERTY

APPLICATION for A PREMISES LICENCE

PURPOSE

To consider the application for the grant of a premises licence in respect of The Junaid's Kebab House & Fast Food, 171, High Street, Brierley Hill, West Midlands.

BACKGROUND

- On the 24th August, 2005, an uncomplete application was received from Sohbat Ali, in respect of the premises known as the Junaid's Kebab House & Fast Food, 171, High Street, Brierley Hill, West Midlands, for the grant of a premises licence, that application was not complete until the 6th December, 2005. The application is attached to this report at Appendix 1.

LAW

- The law relating to the granting of applications to vary premises licences is governed by the Licensing Act 2003, Section 11, Part 3 and Schedule 8, Part 1.
- Pursuant to Section 35(3)(a) of the Licensing Act 2003, where a relevant authority has made representations, the Licensing Authority must:-
 - Hold a hearing to consider item, unless the authority, the applicant and each person who has made such representations agree that a hearing is unnecessary, and
 - Having regard to the representations, take such of steps mentioned in subsection (4) (if any) as it considers necessary for the promotion of the Licensing objectives.
 - The steps are:-
 - · to modify the conditions of licence;
 - to reject the whole or part of the application.
- Pursuant to Section 36(1) and (4) of the Licensing Act 2003 where an application (or any part of an application) is granted or rejected under Section 35 of the Licensing Act 2003, the Licensing Authority must immediately give notice to that effect to:-
 - the applicant;
 - any person who made relevant representations in respect of the application and
 - the Chief Officer of Police for the police area in which the premises are situated.
- In pursuance of Regulation 26(1) of the Licensing Act 2003 (Hearing Regulations 2005), the Licensing Authority must make its determination at the conclusion of the hearing.

- 14 If the Licensing Authority refuse to grant the application to vary the premises licence, there is a right of appeal to the Magistrates' Court pursuant to Schedule 5, Part 1(b).
- Pursuant to Section 4(1), (2) and (3), Schedule 5 of the Licensing Act 2003, where the Licensing Authority grant an application to vary a premises licence in whole or in part. The applicant may appeal against any decision to modify the conditions of the licence under subsection 4(a) of Section 35 of the Licensing Act 2003.

Where a person who made relevant representations to the application desires to contend:-

- that any variation made ought not to have been made, or
- that, when varying the licence, the Licensing Authority ought not to have modified the conditions of the licence, or ought to have modified item in a different way, under subsection 4(a) of Section 35 of the Licensing Act.

They have the right of appeal to the Magistrates' Court.

Extension to Licensing Hours at Junaid's Kebab House, 171 High Street, Brierley Hill

I am writing to register the opposition of the Brierley Hill Traders Association to this application for opening after 11pm.

The late night opening hours of takeaways in Brierley Hill is affecting the character of the townscape.

Brierley Hill is an old fashioned Black Country town with a traditional range of shops and services. I believe that this image is what brings people to shop in Brierley Hill. This image is being destroyed by the large numbers of takeaways which have opened in the town in recent years which is instead promoting the image of Brierley Hill as the takeaway zone for the Waterfront.

The nuisance caused to residents in the town and to other shopkeepers arising from takeaways in the town is well documented. These issues have been raised with Council officers several times at the meetings of the Trader's Association and also in the local press.

The customers of takeaways open late and night already cause noise nuisance which affects residents living in flats above shops in the High Street. There are flats above shops adjacent to the premises in question and noise nuisance from takeaway customers will inevitably disturb them. The Masterplan developed by the Council and the BHRP envisages the further development of Brierley Hill as a residential area – this vision is incompatible with the existence of large numbers of late night takeaways.

Currently, clubbers from the Waterfront, often intoxicated, drive up the town late at night and park outside the existing takeaways. They are often noisy and intoxicated, shouting and disturbing residents above shops. They leave litter and discarded food in profusion on the pavements and often throw their leftovers up the nearest shop window. Whilst waiting to be served they shout at each other, are often intoxicated, and play car stereos loudly.

Through the meetings of the Traders Association there have been many complaints about the amount of rubbish that his generated by the customers of takeaways who make no attempt to dispose of their rubbish in a considerate way but throw food and food wrappers onto the pavements.

This encourages vermin, in particular rats which have frequently been sighted in the High Street and on one occasion as reported in the local press these invaded the Kwik Save, causing the store to close temporarily. These problems were caused by the rubbish generated by takeaways and their customers.

These rubbish problems do not just affect residents but also shopkeepers as we already experience food and wrappers thrown into doorways and sometimes stuffed through letterboxes. They create an additional burden for the Council's street cleaner who has to try to keep the town clean.

The rubbish issues which are an inevitable consequence of takeaways spoil the town's image and damage the local economy.

In addition taxi firms use the carriageway outside the existing takeaways in the High Street as an informal taxi rank, creating congestion and further noise for residents in the town.

The premises in question have very limited provision for consumption of food on the premises and therefore customers will inevitably consume food in the street or in their cars, causing the problems of litter and nuisance described above.

In support of this objection I would be willing to attend the Licensing Committee with members of my Association who have been affected by these issues in order to voice our objections in person.

Extension of Licensing hours for Junaids Kebab House, 171 High Street, Brierley Hill

I am writing to register my objection to this application for opening after 11pm. This application is no more than regularising the practice that has been operated for a number of years under various owner ships.

The planning officer has chosen to ignore the situation.

It is my hope that should this application be unsuccessful that the Licensing Authority will have the teeth to enforce the law.

The noise from late night sounding of horns mainly by taxis delivering or collecting customers from this establishment and others.

The excessive noise from in car stereos.

The screaming and shouting of late night revellers from the Water Front attracted to Brierley Hill by the lateness of hours of the various takeaways. Having to clear up the mess outside my premises every Sunday morning, bits of kebab, chips, vomit, and urine.

Rats which over run the area attracted by the amount of waste food thrown about.

There is also much anti social behaviour, such as Taxi Drivers and others parking on the footpaths, zigzag lines by the pedestrian crossing and even parking across those crossing points.

Let me assure you I have no problem with the owners of this establishment or any other only with late hours they open.

I would like to see a blanket closing time imposed on all Takeaways of 12 Midnight.

Perhaps you would be inform me of any other applications that are subsequently made in Brierley Hill as I think that other establishments may not advertise the applications in their windows
