Closure of Cradley High School

Purpose of Report

1. To advise Schools Forum of the 2007/08 funding process together with the latest revenue budget position in respect of Cradley High school.

Background

- 2. School Organisation Committee approved the closure of Cradley High school on 7 February 2007.
- 3. Schools Forum were advised at the October 2007 meeting of the latest 2007/08 projected budget position for Cradley High School and of the arrangements in place to transfer funding to schools that receive pupils from Cradley High School, as a result of the closure.
- For the 2007/08 financial year, Cradley High has a delegated budget allocation of £1.530m. The latest budget position for Cradley High can now be reported as follows:

5. Whilst the 2007/08 overall budget position is projecting a net deficit of £174k, which will be a charge against the DSG, School's Forum members should note that

- 6. Funding has now been allocated to all Dudley schools receiving pupils from Cradley High School. There are currently 12 pupils for whom we are still awaiting confirmation of destination schools. As soon as this information has been received then transfers of funding in respect of these pupils will be made. A further update will be provided to Schools Forum at the next meeting on 5 February 2008.
- 7. The Directorate is working closely with the headteacher to ensure the assets held by the school are properly safeguarded.

Finance

- 8. The funding of schools is prescribed by the DCSF through the School Finance (Amendment) (England) Regulations 2007.
- 9. Schools Forums are regulated by the School Forums Regulations 2002 as already amended by the Schools Forums (Amendment) Regulations 2004 and the Schools Forums (Amendment) 2005 Regulations.
- 10. From 1st April 2006, the Schools Budget is funded by a direct DCSF grant: Dedicated School Grant (DSG).

Law

11. Councils' LMS Schemes are made under Section 48 of the School Standards and Framework Act 1998. The Education Acts 1996 and 2002 also have provisions relating to school funding.

12. The Council's Equal Opportunities Policy is taken into account when considering the allocation of resources.

Recommendation

13. It is recommended that Schools Forum note the contents of this report in respect of the closure of Cradley High school and advise the Director of Children's Services of any further action necessary.
