

Hello May,

Having considered this application I would make the following points;

There are, as far as I can recall, two traders currently operating in this area. An ice-cream van and a fresh fish stall, although neither are in situ all week.

In addition to this, we have The French Connection in Coventry Street, and a café adjacent to the town clock who place tables and chairs on the highway for customers to eat food purchased from their premises.

The building on the corner of Coventry St/High St is also, I believe, being refitted to operate as a café/restaurant

The area is also an emergency vehicle link.

Given the presence of these traders, and the high profile of the site, with the town clock, I would be reluctant to see another mobile trader adding to the street clutter. Particularly at as time when current traders are struggling and we are receiving a number of complaints regarding street obstructions.

## Hello May

I would object to the siting of a mobile food takeaway adjacent to the Crown Centre. On the plan of where the food takeaway could be located Ms Gould has indicated 4 'squares' 2 of these indicate locations that are at the foot of steps up to the shops at the front of the Crown Centre and with the size of the vehicle indicated in her application this would have the effect of blocking off pedestrian access to the Crown Centre. The 3rd square on the left would mean that the footpath would be blocked. The corner position indicated on another plan by a star would be directly in the way of traffic that is permitted to enter Coventry Street from Lower High St

There are already 2 street trading licences issued in the general area preferred by Ms Gould 1 x Ice cream seller and 1 x wet fish seller. The area around Coventry Street has a number of cafes and hot food takeaways e.g. Daves Deli; Rimskies coffee and tea shops; delicatessen and hot food takeaway in Coventry St I do not believe there is a need for another such food takeaway

Hi Kay

I'm still keeping an eye on things in Stourbridge in Stuart's absence.

My main concern with this application is the number of take way food outlets in Stourbridge already and I think the town centre does already offer an excellent range of food for all needs.

The applicant has requested a location around the Coventry street area where there currently there is:

The French Deli - Coventry Street

French Connection – Coventry Street

Carol's Fish bar - Coventry Street

Bob's big bites caravan – St John's Road (end of Coventry Street)

Rimskis - Crown Centre

Davids Deli - Lower High Street

No. 1 Pizza – Lower High Street

A number of other food outlets operate in the town and I do not believe that there is sufficient need in Stourbridge for this business.

My other concern for this area is that street trading licenses already exist in this area for an ice cream seller and a fish stall and the addition of another trailer would cause a number of issues if all 3 sellers were in on the same day. These issues include restriction of the space available and restricting site lines to existing businesses in Coventry street and Lower High Street

The area is also host to the monthly farmers market on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Saturday of every month, permission for a sood trailer in this area may restrict the area available for the farmers market to set up and again the farmers market usually has a stall selling local sausages in rolls offering yet another option for take away food in the town.

It may also be worth taking into account the forthcoming redevelopment of the Crown Centre which will severely impact on this area of the town and the space available for such activity when the work commences.
