
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

Angela,

I have no observations regarding Mr Fitzpatricks application in relation to his flower stall at Halesowen.

French Market application.

At the outset I would support the application, as this can only benefit the businesses in the town and increase footfall but in order to ensure that there are no problems on the market days so that were a licence to be granted. I would make the following observations.

- 1. What arrangements will be made to <u>inform other retail businesses</u> in the Market Place that they will not be able to receive deliveries on these 3 days (2nd, 3rd and 4th June)? Bon Marche and River Island receive deliveries by articulated vehicles between 8 and 9am on Fridays and Saturdays.
- 2. That a detailled list of goods to be sold is provided prior to the Market date and an undertaking given by the operators that if any goods are put on sale that Dudley Market traders also sell that these goods are removed from sale from the French Market.
- 3. Has the area been <u>measured carefully</u> to ensure that the stalls will fit into the space? As the stall sizes 6m x 3m seem quite large. In the revised application, 3 dates of 2nd 3rd and 4th of June are requested, on the 3rd and 4th of June, Harry Jones has a hot food stall outside Wilkinsons is there enough room for the Market stalls in this area.
 - 4. Access for emergency vehicles must be maintained through the centre of the stalls of the French Market.
 - 5. Turning space in front of the fountain must be maintained.
 - 6. What power source will the traders use to refridgerate fresh meat, cheese etc. currently there is no access to power supply in the Market Place and there are already 2 street traders in the Market Place using petrol generators for their powers supply.
 - 7. Will produce be removed from site and the stalls left set up overnight? what security arrangements will be put in place to prevent anti social behaviour / damage around the empty stalls

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8. The Market Place is pedestrianised from 10am to 4pm (4.30pm on Saturdays). Therefore 9am is too late to commence trading, traders need to be set up and selling by 8 to 8.30am with any vehicles removed by 10am at the very latest. Dudley Market traders are required to remove their vehicles by 9.30am. 6pm is too late to finish trading as vehicles will be allowed in the Market Place after 4pm (4.30pm) and there will be a real risk to pedestrians if the French market is still in full swing.
