88 <u>DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST</u>

Councillor Sparks declared a Personal Interest, in accordance with the Members' Code of Conduct, in relation to item no 5 on the agenda (Revenue Budget Strategy 2008/09) in so far as it related to Dudley Zoo in view of his chairmanship of the Board of that body.

89 REVENUE BUDGET STRATEGY 2008/09

A joint report of the Chief Executive and Director of Finance was submitted seeking consideration of the Revenue Budget Strategy proposed for 2008/09 and later years and presenting proposals for spending and funding options for consultation with Select Committees and representatives of business rate payers.

Questions were asked on the report, with particular reference to certain areas of service that could no longer be funded, including resources made available hitherto for the Ethnic Minority Advisory Service, and to provision for the implications of Single Status, to which the Cabinet Member for Finance and the Director of Finance responded.

Councillor Sparks wished to place on record his disagreement with the Grant "damping" mechanism applied by government to protect losers and limit gainers, like Dudley, when the grant formula was changed.

- (2) That the various issues of risks which will need to be taken into account in finalising budget proposals for 2008/09, and the longer term financial strategy, be noted.
