Report of the Director of Law and Property

Application for French Market (Halesowen Town Centre)

<u>Purpose</u>

1. To consider the application on behalf of Ms Martine Lefrancois for the grant of a Street Trading consent for a French Market in Halesowen Town Centre.

Background

- 2. On the 19th April 2005, Mr Marzolini made application for the grant of a consent to engage in street trading in respect of a French Market in High Street, Dudley for the 9th, 10th and 11th June 2005.
- 3. This application was circulated to the West Midlands Police, Directorate of the Urban Environment, Democratic Services, Town Centre Manager and Julie Jones, Commercial Operations Manager, Corporate Estates.
- 4. Julie Jones, Commercial Operations Manager, Corporate Estates made various comments which were brought to the attention of the Committee.
- 5. The Director of the Urban Environment was unable to comment.
- 6. Dudley Town Centre Manager made comments which were also brought to the attention of the Committee.
- 7. None of the other agencies raised any objections.
- 8. This matter was considered by the Committee on the 27th May 2005. The Committee resolved that the consent be granted.
- 9. On the 6th July, 2005 Mr Marzolini made application for the grant of a further street traders consent for a French Market in Halesowen Town Centre for the 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th August, 2005.

- 10. This application was circulated as in paragraph 3 above.
- 11. The Director of the Urban Environment made comments which were brought to the attention of the Committee.
- 12. The Town Centre Manager also made comments along with Julie Jones, Commercial Operations Manager.
- 13. This application was due to be considered by the Committee however Mr Marzolini made a further/amended application for the 29th September to the 1st October 2005 inclusive. That application was circulated as in paragraph 3. None of the agencies raised objections to the application.
- 14. The Town Centre Manager, Stuart Perry, confirmed his full support for the application.
- 15. This matter was considered by the Committee on the 16th September 2005. The Committee resolved that the consent be granted.
- 16. On the 19th May 2006 Martine Lefrancois made application for the grant of a consent to engage in street trading for a french market in Halesowen Town Centre a copy of the application and site plan are attached to this report as Appendix 1.
- 17. This application was circulated as in paragraph 3 above.
- 18. Stuart Perry, Town Centre Manager gave his support to the application. None of the other agencies raised objections.
- 19. This application has a direct link to the council's key corporate priority that safety matters.

Proposal

20. That the Committee consider Ms Lefrancois' application for the grant of a consent to engage in street trading.

Finance

21. There are no financial implications.

<u>Law</u>

- 22. The grant of consents to engage in street trading is governed by Part III of Schedule IV to the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1982. High Street/Halesowen is a consent streets designated as such by a resolution of the Council. To trade without such a consent is an offence.
- 23. Paragraph 7(2) of Schedule IV of the 1982 Act, states that the Council may grant a consent if it thinks fit and, when granting or renewing a consent, the Council may attach such conditions as it considers necessary.
- 24. Paragraph 10 of Schedule IV of the 1982 Act, states that a street trading consent may be granted for one period not exceeding 12 months but may be revoked at any time.
- 25. Where the consent allows the holder to trade from a cart, barrow, or other vehicle, then the consent must specify the location from which the trade/may trade and the times between which or periods for which he may trade.
- 26. There is no right of appeal against the Council's decision to vary a condition upon which a consent is issued, or refusal to grant or renew a street trader's consent.

27. This report takes account of the Council's policy on equal opportunities.

Recommendation

28. That the Committee determine Ms. Lefrancois' application for the grant of a street trading consent in Halesowen Town Centre.
