## Report of the Director of Law and Property

### **Grant of Street Collection Permit**

### **Purpose of Report**

1. To consider the application on behalf of Mr Andrew Stevens of Shelter for the grant of a street collection permit on behalf of Shelter.

#### **Background**

- 2. On the 12<sup>th</sup> February 2008 Mr Andrew Stevens made application for the grant of a street collection permit on behalf of Shelter. A copy of that application form is attached to this report as Appendix 1.
- 3. That application was circulated to the West Midlands Police, Directorate of the Urban Environment and the Town Centre Management.
- 4. Andrea Jones, Town Centre Manager, made representations which are attached to this report as Appendix 2. None of the other agencies raised objections.
- 5. In January 1999, the licensing section in accordance with the neighbouring Authorities Working Group introduced a policy requiring all street collection applications to submit income and expenditure accounts for the previous financial year. The accounts are attached to this report as Appendix 3.
- 6. This report is submitted for consideration as Shelter would like to conduct their collection by means of direct debit.
- 7. This matter was due to be considered by the Committee on the 8<sup>th</sup> April 2008. The Committee resolved at the request of Mr Stevens to defer the matter to a future hearing.
- 8. This report has a direct link to the Councils priority for safety as the principal reason for submission is safeguarding the public.

#### **Finance**

9. There are no financial implications.

#### Law

- 10. Street collection permits are governed by the Police, Factories etc (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1916.
- 11. Under this Act, the Council have made regulations for street collections.
- 12. The Council has an unfettered discretion to the granting of street collection permits and there are no statutory rights of appeal against the refusal of a street collection permit.

- 14. There has been no consultation or involvement of children and young people in developing these proposals.
