Co-opted Members

Report of the Area Liaison Officer

Purpose of Report

To consider the appointment of persons to serve as co-opted members of the Committee for the 2008/09 municipal year.

Background

- 2. The protocols for Area Committees, re-affirmed by the Council at its meeting held on 15th May,2008, permit them to co-opt up to five persons onto the Committee for the period expiring with the conclusion of each municipal year. Co-opted members are entitled to speak at meetings but not vote.
- 3. The protocol also requires that the Committee, in appointing co-opted members, has due regard to the extent to which persons to be co-opted represent interests of importance within the communities served by the Area Committee. There is a further requirement that co-optees shall not represent the views of any political party on the Area Committee.
- 4. The Committee is now requested to consider the co-option of members for the 2008/09 municipal year.

Finance

5. Co-opted members are entitled to receive travelling and subsistence allowances in accordance with Section 174 of the Local Government Act, 1972 and a Financial Loss Allowance in accordance with Section 173 (4) of that Act.

Law


6. Section 102 (3) of the Local Government Act, 1972, enables the Committee to appoint co-opted members.
