## Report of the Area Liaison Officer

# **Co-opted Members**

## **Purpose of Report**

1. To consider the co-option of persons to serve as co-opted members of the Committee for the 2008/09 Municipal Year.

## **Background**

- 2. The protocols for Area Committees permit Area Committees to co-opt up to five persons onto the Committee for the period expiring with the conclusion of a Municipal Year. Co-opted members are entitled to speak at meetings but not to vote.
- 3. The protocol requires that the Committee, in appointing co-opted members, has due regard to the extent to which persons to be co-opted represent interests of importance within the communities served by the Area Committee. There is a further requirement that co-optees shall not represent the views of any political party on the Area Committee.
- 4. The Cabinet, in March 2006, resolved to suggest to Area Committees that one of the five co-opted places on the Committee be reserved for a representative of young people.
- 5. Mr J Millward was appointed by the Committee, as a co-opted member, to represent young people in June 2006 for the municipal year 2007/08.
- 6. At the meeting of the Committee on 9<sup>th</sup> April, 2008 Mr Millward advised that he would welcome additional support, particularly to represent him at meetings, when study leave would prevent him from attending. Mr Asim Mohammed, who is a volunteer youth worker at the Lower Gornal Youth Academy, has indicated that he would be willing to offer support to Mr Millward, including attendance at meetings.
- 7. The Committee is now requested to consider the co-option of members for the 2008/09 Municipal Year.

#### **Finance**

8. Co-opted members are entitled to receive travelling and subsistence allowances in accordance with Section 174 of the Local Government Act, 1972 and a Financial Loss Allowance in accordance with Section 173(4) of that Act.

#### Law

9. Section 102(3) of the Local Government Act, 1972, provides for a Committee of the Council to include persons who are not members of the Council.

# **Equality Impact**

10. This report complies fully with the Council's policy on equality and diversity. The views of young people are represented through the appointment of one of the co-opted members.

# **Recommendations**

11. The Committee is requested to determine the co-opted members for the 2008/09 Municipal Year.
