BACKGROUND

- Initially, a complaint was received regarding the erection of a conservatory at 31 Woodland Road Halesowen in July 2005. Following a correspondence with the owners it was noted that the conservatory was in place and that no planning permission had been given for it.
- 2. The owner was contacted by letter on the 5th August 2005 and a retrospective planning application for the retention of the conservatory was subsequently submitted. This was refused under delegated powers on 14th December 2005.
- 3. A letter was sent to the owners on the 6th January 2006, asking them to remove the structure.

BREACH OF PLANNING CONTROL

The unauthorised erection of a conservatory at 31 Woodland Road, Halesowen, West Midlands, B63 8JS. (see attached plan)

WHAT IS REQUIRED TO BE DONE

5 The removal of the conservatory from the land in its entirety.

TIME FOR COMPLIANCE

6 2 months

REASONS FOR ENFORCEMENT

The conservatory by virtue of its size and position is detrimental to the residential amenities of the adjoining neighbours at 29 Woodland Road; as such this is contrary to Policy DD4 - Development in Residential Areas; Planning Guidance Note 12 - The 45 Degree Code and Planning Guidance Note 17 - House Extension Design Guide.
