# **Report of the Director of Corporate Resources**

#### **Responses to Questions**

#### **Purpose of Report**

1. To inform the Committee of written responses made to questions asked at a previous meeting.

### **Background**

- **2.** At a meeting of this Committee held on 8<sup>th</sup> March 2010, it was indicated that written replies would be sent to the questioners on the following questions:
  - A member of the public raised concerns at that the footpath leading from Wollescote Road into Stevens Park was his concern that the footpath between the centre of Stevens Park and Wollescote Road was muddy and running with water in wet weather.
- 3. In response to the concerns expressed at the meeting on the 8<sup>th</sup> March, the Group Engineer Traffic and Road Safety undertook a site walk with the questioner and has written to the questioner advising that the Council's Parks Management has been asked to consider the request for the footpath to be upgraded to make it safer to walk on when the weather is rainy or icy.
- 4. A member of the public queried whether it would be possible to establish a re-use shop facility for Stourbridge on the car park in Birmingham Road, run by volunteers, similar to one referred to which had been established in a neighbouring local authority, where large quantities of waste were diverted from landfill and provided an income for a charity. The Head of Waste Care has investigated the matter and written to the questioner advising that, whilst the idea of a re-use shop facility has merits, there are significant practical problems to overcome before this idea could come to fruition at the Stourbridge site.
