



"Compared to Wordsley they are excellent"


"My daughter loves it here, it's exceeded my expectations"

"It's a shame about the park, otherwise good local area"


"I don't like the park when its dark, but I'm happy to use the car park entrance"

"How over subscribed you are for things like PEEP. As family who don't 'tick' the boxes I feel like I'm left out a bit because I can afford to pay to do things"


"That there is no play group on a Monday"








