Capital Allocations - Recommendations

Summary of New Applications by Ward

CASTLE & PRIORY WARD

1. St Francis Parish Centre

The recommendation is that this group be awarded a capital grant of **£810.00** to improve the wheelchair access to the Centre, including the ramp and the front door.

2. Caves OAP Group

The recommendation is that this group be awarded a capital grant of **£500.00** to purchase a bingo machine and kitchen items

3. **Priory Park Amateur Boxing Club**

The recommendation is that more information be obtained about the future of the premises of this group and reported to the Area Committee before agreeing their application for £4850.00 to install new changing and toilet facilities.

4. **Dudley Sea Cadets**

The recommendation is that more information be obtained about the practicalities of their application and reported to the Area Committee, before agreeing a grant award for the purposes of installing security fencing.

NETHERTON, WOODSIDE & ST ANDREWS WARD

5. Darby End TRA

The recommendation is that this group be awarded a capital grant of **£848.00** to purchase 106 plastic bins for placing their black refuse bags into prior to collection.

6. Woodside Community Association

The recommendation is that this group be awarded a capital grant of **£5,000.00** to refit their kitchen in accordance with Health & Safety guidelines and to furnish the waiting area and chairs.

7. 1st Primrose Hill Guides

The recommendation is that this group be awarded a capital grant of **£847.96** to purchase tables and chairs.

8. Netherton United Women's Football Club

The recommendation is that this group be awarded a capital grant of **£400.00** to purchase training and match equipment.

QUARRY BANK & DUDLEY WOOD WARD

9. WM Police – Netherton Office

The recommendation is that this group be awarded a capital grant of **£3048.00** to purchase cycle uniforms for 4 Police Constables and 4 Police Community Support Officers.

(Although this police station is based in Netherton, a large part of their patrols take place in the Dudley Wood area, which is why the Ward of Quarry Bank & Dudley Wood is covering this grant award).

ST JAMES'S WARD

10. WM Police – Dudley Office

The recommendation is that this group be awarded a capital grant of **£338.40** to Purchase 1 cycle uniform for a PCSO.

11. Dudley Christian Fellowship

The recommendation is that this group be awarded a capital grant of **£3,000.00** to contribute towards the purchase of new items of kitchen equipment.

ALL WARDS

12. Relate Dudley

The recommendation is that this group be awarded a total amount of **£4,900.65**, that is **£980.13** per Ward, to redecorate, carpet and refurnish their Dudley premises. They help about 300 Dudley residents per year.

13. Community Transport Dudley

The recommendation is that this group be awarded in principle a capital grant of **£1000.00** i.e. **£200.00** per Ward to contribute towards the purchase of a secondhand minibus that they are currently leasing.

However as the transport service they provide covers the whole of the Borough, each Area Committee has been asked to consider the award of £1,000.00 to make up the total of £5,000 that is required to purchase the minibus.

This being the case, if other Area Committees decide not to award £1,000.00 then the application can only proceed, if we receive confirmation that the CTD can raise the remainder from other sources.

At the time of writing, it is understood that North Dudley Area Committee have refused the application.
