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#### Background

- 2. During the last 18 months a number of formula factors have been discussed and reviewed by Head Teachers Consultative Forum Budget Working Group (HTCF-BWG) to assess their effectiveness at targeting funding resources. Schools Forum has been kept informed of these discussions on an ongoing basis.
- 3. As a result there are now four formula factors which are proposed for amendment from April 2009.
- 4. It is requirement that all Head Teachers and Governing Bodies are consulted in the preceding financial year on any proposed variations to the Local Management of Schools (LMS) funding formula. A copy of the draft consultation document is attached at Appendix A, financial details of the proposed changes are attached at Appendices B and C.
- 5. The consultation period will be from October 2008 to January 2009. A final report will be presented to the Schools Forum meeting in February 2009 advising members of the outcomes and the resulting recommendations of the Director of Children's Services.

#### **Finance**

- 6. The funding of schools is prescribed by the DCSF through the School Finance (England) Regulations 2008.
- 7. Schools Forums are regulated by the School Forums Regulations 2002 as already amended by the Schools Forums (Amendment) Regulations 2004 the Schools Forums (Amendment) 2005 Regulations and the Schools Forums (England) (Amendment) Regulations 2008.

8. From 1<sup>st</sup> April 2006, the Schools Budget has been funded by a direct DCSF grant: Dedicated School Grant (DSG). The ISB (Individual Schools Budget which covers the delegated budgets to schools) is a part of the Schools Budget.

## Law

9. Councils' LMS Schemes are made under Section 48 of the School Standards and Framework Act 1998. The Education Acts 1996 and 2002 also have provisions relating to school funding.

## **Equality Impact**

10. The Council's Equal Opportunities Policy is taken into account when considering the allocation of resources.

## Recommendations
