What is a Foundation Trust?

- Different type of NHS Trust
- Independently regulated by Monitor
- Offers more financial freedoms – better local services
- Locally accountable

All NHS Trusts are expected to attain FT status by 2015

Who are we?

- Acute Hospital serving 405,155 people across the Dudley Borough as well as Sandwell, Wyre Forest, and South Staffs
- Budget circa £250m in 2009/10
- Russells Hall Hospital has over 700 beds, approximately 75 Day Case Beds & 41 delivery rooms
- Over 520 thousand contacts with patients per year

State of the Art Hospitals and Equipment



What did we do in 2009?

We:-

- saw 495,974 Outpatients
- treated 95,732 patients in the Emergency Department
- treated 52,891 Emergency Admissions
- treated 10,562 Inpatients
- treated 37,208 Day Case patients
- performed 28,524 inpatient & day case procedures
- delivered 3,333 babies

 - Option to stand as a governor to represent constituency

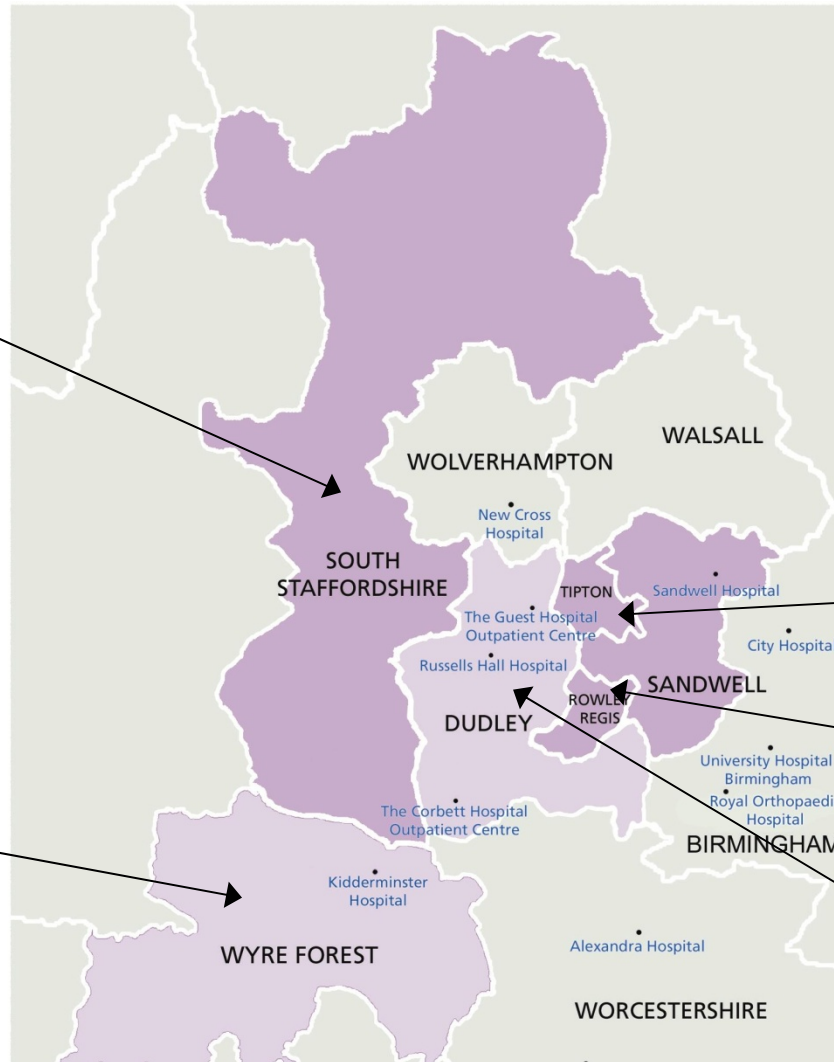
Public Constituencies and the number of Governors

The Council of Governors

- Appoint and remove Chairman and Non Executive Directors
- Approve appointment of Chief Executive
- Appoint and remove the auditor
- Right to comment on major changes to services
- Review performance information
- Be consulted on forward planning
- Representing the interests of Members
