RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE AREA COMMITTEE - 4 NOVEMBER 2004

1.0 Summary of New Applications by Ward

CASTLE & PRIORY WARD

1.1 Priory Tenants & Residents Association

The recommendation is that this organization be awarded a capital grant of £700.00, to purchase a laptop computer to assist the administration of the Association.

NETHERTON, WOODSIDE & ST ANDREW'S WARD

1.2 Netherton News Group

The recommendation is that this organization be awarded a capital grant of £2,000.00, to contribute to the purchase of a colour copier to improve the presentation of their newsletter and assist other groups with their printing.

1.3 Cole Street Methodist Church

The recommendation is that this organization be awarded a capital grant of £1,900.00, to provide disabled toilet facilities under the provisions of the DDA, for the community groups using the church hall.

1.4 Age Concern Dudley

The recommendation is that this organization be awarded a capital grant of £2015.00, to purchase new furniture and equipment for their Nightingale Activity Centre.

QUARRY BANK & DUDLEY WOOD WARD

1.5 The Brook Club

The recommendation is that this organization be awarded a capital grant of £175.00, to purchase a large capacity boiler, teapot and kettle.

ST JAMES'S WARD

1.6 Russells Hall Neighbourhood Centre

The recommendation is that this organization be awarded a capital grant of £2,000.00, to contribute towards the cost of a music and recording facility for young people and the community, provided free of charge.

1.7 St Barnabas Church Hall

The recommendation is that this organization be awarded a capital grant of £2000.00, to contribute towards the cost of new windows in a hall widely used by the local community.

1.8 Dynamic Time Out

The recommendation is that this organization be awarded a capital grant of £1,063.55, to purchase new furniture and equipment and improve the flooring.

1.9 Dudley MBC – Directorate of the Urban Environment (DUE)

The recommendation is that DUE acting in line with community aspirations, be awarded a capital grant of £2000.00, to help towards the cost of providing an extension to the skatepark at Russell's Hall Open Space.

ST THOMAS'S WARD

1.10 Kate's Hill Darby & Joan Club

The recommendation is that this organization be awarded a capital grant of £300.00 to purchase 2 tea trolleys, tables and a bingo machine.
