## Report of the Area Liaison Officer

## **Co-opted Members**

## **Purpose of Report**

1. To consider the co-option of persons to serve as co-opted members of the Committee for the 2012/2013 Municipal Year.

#### **Background**

- The protocols for Area Committees permit Area Committees to co-opt up to five persons onto the Committee for the period expiring with the conclusion of a Municipal Year. Co-opted members are entitled to speak at meetings but not to vote.
- 3. The protocol requires that the Committee, in appointing co-opted members, has due regard to the extent to which persons to be co-opted represent interests of importance within the communities served by the Area Committee. There is a further requirement that co-optees shall not represent the views of any political party on the Area Committee.
- 4. The Cabinet, in March 2006, resolved that it be suggested to Area Committees that one of their vacancies for a co-opted member be reserved for a representative of young people.
- 5. The following persons were appointed as co-opted members of the Committee in the 2011/2012 Municipal Year, representing the organisations indicated. These members have been asked if they wish to continue to serve and responses received to date are as follows:
  - Ms. G. Lawley Dudley Association of Governing Bodies (wishes to continue)
  - Mrs. V. Little Dudley Primary Care Trust (wishes to continue)
  - Ms. J. Oakes Dudley Town Centre Forum (wishes to continue)
  - Mr. K. Rodney Dudley Centre for Equality and Diversity (wishes to continue)
- 6. The Committee is now requested to consider the co-option of members for the 2012/2013 Municipal Year.

#### **Finance**

7. Co-opted members are entitled to receive travelling and subsistence allowances in accordance with Section 174 of the Local Government Act, 1972 and a Financial Loss Allowance in accordance with Section 173(4) of that Act.

## <u>Law</u>

8. Section 102(3) of the Local Government Act, 1972, provides for a Committee of the Council to include persons who are not members of the Council.

## **Equality Impact**

9. This report enables the Area Committee to consider the appointment of local co-opted members in order to assist in making meetings more representative of the local community.

## Recommendations

10. The Committee is requested to determine the co-opted members for the 2012/2013 Municipal Year.
