The Thomas Leslie Tibbetts Gift

Purpose of Report

 To obtain the Committee's agreement to the adoption of the name 'The Thomas Leslie Tibbetts Gift' to a gift which is to be registered with the Charity Commission.

Background

- In 1966 the land shown on the plan attached, was donated to the Council by Thomas Leslie Tibbetts, a local auctioneer, 'for the perpetual use thereof by the public for the purpose of exercise and recreation'
- The land has been used since then as part of a larger area for football pitches and general recreation.
- 4. It has recently been noticed that because of the particular wording of the Gift, it should be registered as a charity with the Charity Commission. The Charity Commission requires a suitable name for the Charity and it is suggested that the above name is adopted, as it comprises the name of the Donor of the Gift. A check has been made with the Charity Commission, and no other charity is registered with this name.
