Notice is hereby given in accordance with section 29(1) of the School Standards and Framework Act 1998 that Dudley Metropolitan Borough Council intends to discontinue Beauty Bank Primary School, Forge Road, Stourbridge, West Midlands, DY8 1XF from 31 August 2006.

Alternative accommodation will be available at Greenfields, Amblecote, St. James C. of E. and Gig Mill Primary Schools.

It is proposed from September 2006 that the Beauty Bank site will become a temporary annexe of Greenfields Primary School and provide for those children whose parents have expressed a preference for Greenfields Primary School. The Governing Body at Greenfields Primary School will assume responsibility for all aspects of the Beauty Bank annexe. The headteacher of Greenfields Primary School will be responsible for the overall leadership and management of both sites. It is expected that staff currently at Beauty Bank will transfer to the staffing establishment of Greenfields Primary School. Greenfields Primary School will operate initially from its present site at Hill Street, Stourbridge and Forge Road, Stourbridge until consolidation on a single site from September 2007.

The current Authority's Transport policy will pertain to address any issues.
