In respect of the above application for the variation of a Premises Licence, I wish to make a representation on the grounds that the proposed variation is likely to impact on the licensing objective of preventing public nuisance.

The application is seeking to extend the opening hours and provision of late night refreshment on Sundays to Thursdays from 23:30 until 05:00 and on Fridays and Saturdays from 00:00 until 05:00. The restaurant is in close proximity to residential premises in Ketley Road and next door to a residential hotel. This department has received two complaints regarding noise nuisance from McDonalds. One complainant from a near by residential property was allegedly disturbed by car noise from the drive- through at McDonalds late at night. The second complaint concerned noise from cars revving and noise from car stereos on the car park late at night. The application seeks to considerably increase the opening hours of the restaurant but no additional steps have been put forward to in order to control the potential for increased noise nuisance issues from the car park.

I would therefore raise an objection to the above application to vary the Premises Licence.
