## 19 **Community Forum Funding**

<u>Application</u> <u>Recommendation</u>

Halesowen Chamber of Trade Approval of £2,500 from the High Street

Innovation Fund/Empty Shops Grant to

purchase Christmas lights for Halesowen Town Centre.

Shell Corner Partnership Approval of £600 plus VAT from the

High Street Innovation Fund/Empty Shops Grant to purchase Christmas trees to be mounted on lampposts.

(Councillor H Bills declared an interest in the above application as Secretary of the

Shell Corner Partnership).

Halesowen and Rowley Regis Rotary Club

Approval of £2,170 from the High Street Innovation Fund/Empty Shops Grant to support the fun run and road race, specifically road closure costs, road management charges and car park hire levy.

Coombeswood Sports and Social Club (Bowling Section)

Approval of up to £4,500 to complete the installation of floodlights and electric cable plus fuse boxes around the bowling green, subject to confirmation of planning approval and that the installation would not have a negative impact on local residents and wildlife.

Members indicated that consideration be given to allow non-members to utilise the bowling green.

Halesowen Chamber of Trade

Approval of £7,500 to comprise the remaining balance of the High Street Innovation Fund/Empty Shops Grant funding, with the remainder to be allocated from the Community Forum fund. This would contribute towards the development of a proposal for a Business Improvement District (BID) in Halesowen Town Centre and that the application be referred for consideration at Belle Vale and Hayley Green Community Forum.

The Church of God

It was noted that the funding was no longer necessary.

The Lead Officer referred to previous funding grants awarded that had not been claimed. Following consideration, Members agreed that sufficient time had been given for organisations to access the approved funding and agreed that the balances be returned to the Community Forum fund to be used for future awards.
