- 2.1 At a meeting of this Committee held on the 9th November 2004, it was indicated that written replies would be sent to the questioners concerned. The responses are as indicated
- 2.2 In response to a query regarding the demolition of the derelict toilet block in King George VI Park in Wordsley and information regarding Green Care costs for the provision and erection of fencing, the Director of the Urban Environment has written advising that the demolition of the toilet block has been completed and the costing to date for the fencing.
- 2.3 In response to a query regarding the feasibility of a direct train link from Stourbridge Junction to Birmingham New Street Station, the Director of the Urban Environment has written advising that there

are currently six services per hour operating between Stourbridge and Birmingham, Monday to Saturday with reduced services on Sundays.
