Annual audit fee 2009/10

Further to our discussions, I am writing to confirm the audit work that we propose to undertake for the 2009/10 financial year at Dudley MBC. The fee is based on the risk-based approach to audit planning as set out in the Code of Audit Practice and work mandated by the Audit Commission for 2009/10.

As I have not yet completed my audit for 2008/09 the audit planning process for 2009/10, including the risk assessment will continue as the year progresses and fees will be reviewed and updated as necessary.

The total indicative fee for the audit for 2009/10 is for £300,969 which compares to the planned fee of £289,848 for 2008/09. A summary of this is shown in the table below.

The Audit Commission has published its work programme and scales of fees 2009/10. The scale fee for Dudley MBC is £335,838. The fee proposed for 2009/10 is 10 per cent below the scale fee.

In setting the fee at this level, I have assumed that the general level of risk in relation to the audit of the financial statements is not significantly different from that identified to 2008/09. A separate plan for the audit of the financial statements will be issued in December 2009. This will detail the risks identified, planned audit procedures and any changes in fee. If I need to make any significant amendments to the audit fee during the course of the audit, I will first discuss this with the Director of Finance and then prepare a report outlining the reasons why the fee needs to change for discussion with the Audit Committee.

My value for money conclusion will be based upon the evidence from three themes:

- Managing finances;
- Governing the business; and
- Managing resources.

The key lines of enquiry specified for the assessment are set out in the Audit Commission's work programme and scales of fees 2009/10. I have identified significant risks in relation to my value for money conclusion for which I will consider the arrangements put in place by Dudley MBC to mitigate the risk, and plan my work accordingly. My initial risk assessment is shown in the table below:
