Thank you for your letter dated 5/7/06 regarding the above. The only comments we as the Fire Authority (made on their behalf by myself) are as follows:

Cumulative impact would not really have any effect to the " public safety " licensing objective as far as we are concerned. Matters for our concern remain the same, save for the possibility of increased occupancy and overcrowding. Any other breaches of fire safety regulations could occur regardless of whether CUMULATIVE IMPACT exists or not. Representations would have to be made by someone to prove this had occurred.
