# Responses to Questions Raised at the Halesowen Area Committee held on 3<sup>rd</sup> July 2007

## **Purpose of Report**

1. To inform the Committee of the written responses made to questions asked at the previous meeting.

#### **Background**

- 2. At the meeting of this Committee held on 3<sup>rd</sup> July 2007, a question was raised under the Public Forum item and the response to that question is as follows:-
- 3. A resident referred to a recent media article and expressed concern that it had been reported that there was a possible threat to the existence of the Council's Neighbourhood Management Unit. She stated that the Neighbourhood Management Unit were a main supporter of Caslon Primary School and it was indicated that the school and the community had not been consulted about the issue. She requested that the Committee use its influence to ensure that the support received from the Neighbourhood Management Unit was retained so that the excellent work could continue, particularly with regard to the success of the extended school and the Caslon Community Partnership. The Area Liaison Officer undertook to ensure that details were submitted to the Committee when available.
