<u>Financial Monitoring – Schools Budget for 2006/07 Financial Year</u> <u>Purpose of Report</u>

1. To provide Schools Forum with the latest budget monitoring data to the 31 May 2006, in respect of the Schools Budget for the 2006/07 financial year.

Background

- 2. The Schools Forum is responsible for the allocation of the Dedicated Schools Grant (DSG) for 2006/07.
- 3. For 2006/07 financial year the DfES have now confirmed the DSG at £173.955m. The DSG funds the Schools Budget. The Schools Budget is a combination of centrally retained budgets together with the ISB (Individual Schools Budget).
- 4. Appendix A details the latest financial monitoring report in respect of the DSG for the 2006/07 financial year, allocated over the Schools Budget areas.
- 5. The monitoring report attached currently reflects the DSG at the higher value of £174.4m. The budget will be amended to £173.955m after Schools Forum have agreed the strategy regarding the £489k reduction in DSG.
- 6. Any DSG balance at 31 March 2007 will be carried forward to the next financial year. If the year-end balance is a surplus then this will be available for distribution within the Schools Budget, if the balance is a deficit then this will be top sliced from the 2007/08 DSG.
- 7. The financial monitoring report will be discussed in more detail at the Forum's meeting on 11 July.
- 8. The monitoring report is discussed in detail on a monthly basis with the Director of Children's Services and relevant budget holders.

Finance

9. The funding of schools is prescribed by the DfES through the School Finance (England) Regulations 2006.

10. From 1st April 2006, the Schools Budget will be funded by a direct DfES grant: Dedicated School Grant (DSG).

Law

11. Councils' LMS Schemes are made under Section 48 of the School Standards and Framework Act 1998. The Education Acts 1996 and 2002 also have provisions relating to school funding.

12. The Council's Equal Opportunities Policy is taken into account when considering the allocation of resources.

Recommendation

13. Schools Forum to note the contents of the financial monitoring report attached at Appendix A in respect of the current financial year 2006/07 and advise the Director of Children's Services accordingly.
