Closure of Cradley High School

Purpose of Report

1. To advise Schools Forum of the 2007/08 budget process in respect of Cradley High school.

Background

- 2. School Organisation Committee approved the closure of Cradley High school on 7 February 2007.
- 3. The distribution of delegated funds to Cradley High school for 2007/08 will be in accordance with the School Finance Regulations (England) 2006, which permit amendments to a school's budget where a school is closing or changing during the financial year.
- 4. Schools Forum were advised at the February 2007 meeting that Cradley High school's delegated budget could show a deficit of £1m by 31 March 2008, and that forward financial planning would be necessary immediately in order to manage this process and minimise the deficit situation; any closing school deficit will be a charge against the DSG.
- 5. This report identifies the proposed budget distribution for 2007/08. Appendix A details the 2007/08 formula budget for Cradley High together with the funds 'clawed back' in respect of the current year 7, 8 and 9 pupils who will transfer to alternative schools in September 2007. The budget of £722k set aside for the period September to March 2008, will be used to fund those pupils transferring from September 2007 as part of the managed move process. This allocation will be distributed to schools in September 2007 once the Admissions team has confirmed the destination of all pupils. The 'one off' allowance of £175 per pupil in respect of a uniform allowance (£75) and in recognition of the additional management and administration costs incurred due to the admissions process (£100), will also be funded from the £722k but a separate distribution process will be proposed in due course.
- 6. The Assistant Director of Resources will update Schools Forum as to the processes that will be put into place in order to minimise the 2007/08 year end deficit position for Cradley High school. This will include the setting up of a Steering Group to assist with the financial management of the school and could include the withdrawal of delegation, if the Director of Children's Services requests this course of action.

7. It is proposed that a regular updated report is presented to Schools Forum identifying the latest position.

Finance

- 8. The funding of schools is prescribed by the DfES through the School Finance (England) Regulations 2006.
- 9. From 1st April 2006, the Schools Budget is funded by a direct DfES grant: Dedicated School Grant (DSG).

<u>Law</u>

10. Councils' LMS Schemes are made under Section 48 of the School Standards and Framework Act 1998. The Education Acts 1996 and 2002 also have provisions relating to school funding.

Equality Impact

11. The Council's Equal Opportunities Policy is taken into account when considering the allocation of resources.

Recommendation

- 12. It is recommended that Schools Forum:
 - a. Note the process for distributing the 2007/08 delegated budget for Cradley High schools and advise the Director of Children's Services accordingly regarding the estimated £1m deficit budget which is expected to occur unless tight financial management is exercised immediately;
 - b. Request that regular updates are presented to Schools Forum in respect of the closure process for Cradley High school.
