Board School Gardens – Prohibition of Waiting	Petition of 87 signatures customers of Saver Express Shop on Clarence Street. Double yellow lines outside shop. Shop owner concerned that prohibiting waiting in Board School Gardens will drive away customers and result in loss of business	Residents of Board School Gardens are mainly elderly and have been campaigning for some time to prevent parking which is causing them concern and considerable nuisance. The objection should be over-ruled.
The Arcade – Prohibition & Restriction of Waiting	Following discussion with workers based in the area, it is felt that the restrictions could result in displaced parking into residential streets.	Objections should be upheld to prevent unwanted displaced parking into residential streets.
The Arcade – One Way Order	There were no objections to the proposal to make the Arcade One Way	The One-Way Order was proposed to support the proposed prohibition and restriction of waiting in the Arcade. If these proposals are not to be implemented, the One-Way is not required.
Pale Street- Prohibition of Waiting	From one resident of Pale Street, supported by Ward Members, prohibition should be both sides of Pale Street	The Prohibition of Waiting should be implemented as advertised and a Prohibition of Waiting should be advertised on the opposite side of the street.
