SITE AND SURROUNDINGS

- The trees subject to this application are 1 Corsican Pine; 1 Spruce; 1 Fir; 2 Birch; 2
 Apple; 15 Cypress and 2 Cypress hedges. The trees are all situated in the rear
 garden of Dreycote, Quarry Park Road.
- 2. Dreycote is a new property that has been built in the grounds of Grantchester, Quarry Park Road. Due to the tree's location in the rear garden they are not visible from any public vantage. As such they all have a low amenity value.

PROPOSAL

- 3. Summary of proposals for the works as written on application form is as follows:
 - Fell 1 Corsican pine; 1 spruce; 2 birch; 2 apple; 15 Cypress trees; 2 cypress hedges; and prune 1 fir tree.
- 4. The trees have been marked on the attached plan.

HISTORY

5. There have been no previous Tree Preservation Order applications on this site.

Further Assessment

- 8. The applicant has intends to carry out the proposed works in order to allow the relandscaping of the garden. The landscaping that is to be carried out includes substantial shrub planting, the creation of a lawned area and the planting of 11 trees.
- 9. On inspection all of the trees were considered to have a low amenity value. This is due to the tree not being visible form any public vantage. Due to this low amenity value, government guidance states that a lesser amount of justification is required in order to grant approval for their removal.
- 10. The majority of the trees subject to this application are cypress trees. These are predominantly centred on the southwest corner of the garden where there are a number of densely planted cypresses (T5, T6, and T9 T20). It is the applicant's intention to remove these trees and replace them with a number of ornamental maple trees and fruit trees. There will be fewer trees planted than are removed, however this is considered acceptable due as this will allow an appropriate amount of space for the trees to develop fully.
- 11. The applicant also proposes the removal of two sections of cypress hedge (T22 & T23). Again the hedges provide little in the way of public amenity, and therefore there are no objections to their removal. The applicants have proposed to replant one of the hedges with a beech hedge in order to extend the existing beech hedge on the southern boundary.
- 12. The proposal also includes the removal and replacement of two apple trees, on inspection these were found to be in a poor condition and they will be liable to enter into terminal decline within the next 5 years. As such their removal is considered to be acceptable.
- 13. Two birch trees (T3 & T21) are also shown to be removed. Again these trees are in poor heath, with one of them liable to collapse in the near future. Ageing due to their low public amenity value their removal is considered appropriate.
- 14. The tree to be pruned as part of this application is a mature fir tree that is situated in the rear garden of property. The tree is close to the patio area, and the lower branches hang down to around head height. The proposed work is to crown lift the

- tree to allow more clearance over head. This works is only minor and will have no detrimental impact on the health or amenity value of the tree
- 15. Overall the proposals are considered acceptable. Whilst the felling of 23 trees may appear drastic when considered as part of the re-landscaping of the garden is considered to be reasonable and appropriate. Due to the current low amenity value of the trees, the works will have little or no impact on the amenity value of the area.

CONCLUSION

- 16. This application proposes the removal of 23 trees and the pruning of a fir tree as part of the re-landscaping of the property. The trees are all situated in the rear garden of the property and are not public visible. Due to the lack of public visibility they provide little in the way of public amenity to the area.
- 17. The proposed works will have no impact on the amenity of the area, and as such it would be contrary to government guidance to refuse the application.

RECOMMENDATION

18. It is recommended that application is approved subject to the conditions set out below.

Conditions and/or reasons:

- 1. The tree works subject of this consent shall be carried out in accordance with British Standard BS 3998:1989 'Recommendations for Treework'.
- 2. The works hereby approved shall be carried out within 12 months of the date of this decision.
- 3. Ten replacement trees shall be planted between the beginning of November and the end of March, within 1 year of felling (and replanted if necessary) and maintained until satisfactorily established. The size, species and location of the replacement trees shall be agreed in writing with the Local Planning authority prior to the felling of the trees to which this application relates.


