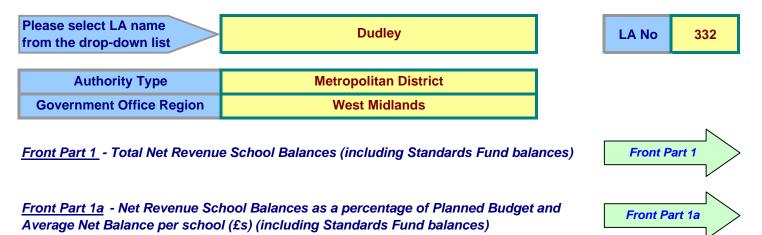

School Balances Analysis Tool

Summary information is presented in 'Front Part 1' and 'Front Part 1a' within this spreadsheet.

'Front Part 1' Total Net Revenue School Balances (including Standards Fund Balances)

Purpose of this table

This table shows the actual school balances at 31st March 2006 compared with actual school balances the previous two years. It gives results for the Council selected and a comparison with the other groups, and the overall England position.

The first block within the table shows total aggregate balances in cash against comparators. The second block shows the total aggregate balances against the average Council balance in each group.

Both blocks show the trend over the three year period; 2003/04, 2004/05 and 2005/06.

For example if City of Kingston upon Hull is selected on the 'Front' sheet, the comparators are automatically inserted; regional, unitary, county etc from the drop down menus) the following interpretation can be made of the tables in 'Front Part 1'.

City of Kingston upon Hull's actual total school balances have reduced during the financial year ending 31st March 2006 by £649,228 to £4,741,654. Total school balances as a percentage of the planned budget allocated in 2005/06 equates to 3.96%. This compares to 3.76% in 2004/05 and 5.15% in 2003/04.

In summary City of Kingston upon Hull's total school balances have reduced by £649,000 in 2005/06.

This compares with the overall England position as follows.

England's total school balances have increased slightly from £1.51 billion overall to £1.54 billion by the end of March 2006. The size of the overall planned budget allocated to England schools in 2005/06 increased, however in percentage terms, balances have reduced from 6.86% to 6.65%.

'Front Part 1a' Net Revenue School Balances as a percentage of Planned Budget and Average Net Balance per school (£) (including Standards Fund balances)

Purpose of this table

To enable analysis of school balances across sectors (primary, secondary & special). Detail is provided in six tables, showing the position of the net balance, surplus balances only and deficit balances only.

The first table shows the percentage net balances at sector level at 31st March 2006 compared with percentage net balances the previous two years. It gives results for the Council selected and a comparison with the other groups, and the overall England average position.

For example if City of Kingston upon Hull is selected the following interpretation can be made of the first table. Actual total school balances in primary schools have increased during the financial year ended 31st March 2006 by 1.34% to 6.50%. Secondary school balances have reduced by 1.36% to 0.70%. Both primary and secondary are well below the other comparators.

The second table shows the average net balances at sector level at 31st March 2006 compared with average net balances the previous two years. It gives results for the Council selected and a comparison with the other groups, and the overall England average position.

For example if City of Kingston upon Hull is selected the following interpretation can be made of the second table. Average net balances in primary schools have increased during 2005/06 by \pounds 3,923 to \pounds 49,910. The Secondary schools average balance has reduced by \pounds 65747 to \pounds 25,538. This is well below the other comparators.

The other four tables allow you to drill down specifically on the make up of the net balance i.e. surplus and deficit balances. This includes the percentage of schools in surplus or deficit and the average balances across sectors.

For example if City of Kingston upon Hull is selected the tables show the percentage of secondary schools in deficit has increased during 2005/06 by 20% to 33.33%. At 31st March 2006 33.33% of secondary schools were in deficit. The percentage of primary schools in deficit increased during 2005/06 by 9.1% to 19.48%. At 31st March 2006 19.48% of primary schools were in deficit. The other tables show the average balances in cash terms.

The other parts of the spreadsheet allow you to drill down further into the base data and follow through the actual number of schools in deficit or surplus in both years.

Information on how LA averages have been calculated are detailed in the 'Notes' section within the spreadsheet.

Notes

Total deficit is cumulative negative balances in each Local Authority (LA). Total surplus is cumulative positive balances in LA (including zero balances). Total balance is cumulative balance of all schools in the LA.

City of London and Isles of Scilly have been excluded from all average calculations, as each of these authorities only has one school. For London, the Regional groupings and Authority Type groupings do not exactly correspond (see London Groupings below). The Planned Budget Share is split between those in deficit, those in surplus and the total Planned Budget Share.

Calculations

Group average calculations are the mean average for individual LA positions:

e.g. the England Average 'Balance as a % of Planned Budget' is the 'Balance as % of Planned Budget' for each LA, divided by the total number of LAs. Group total calculations are the overall position for that group of LAs:

e.g. the England Total 'Balance as a % of Planned Budget' in Part 1 is the sum of all LA Balances divided by the sum of all LA Planned Budgets.
