## Appointment of Independent Member to the Standards Committee

### Purpose of Report

1. To consider the arrangements for and the making of a recommendation to the Council on the appointment of an Independent Member to serve on the Standards Committee.

## **Background**

- 2. The Bishop of Dudley was appointed to serve as an Independent Member on the Standards Committee in April,2006, for a second four year term ending on 26<sup>th</sup> April,2010.
- 3. The Standards Board for England (SBE) has previously issued guidance that the appointment of independent members should be on the basis of a term of 4 years with a maximum of 2 terms but that this is at the discretion of each authority. The guidance also states however that independent members cannot be automatically re-appointed and must go through a recruitment process.
- 4. In the light of the guidance therefore although the Bishop could be considered for appointment for a further four year term arrangements must be made for advertisement of the appointment, interviews and the making of a recommendation to the meeting of Council to be held on 26<sup>th</sup> April,2010.
- 5. Given the previous experience with such appointments it is suggested that I be authorised to make all the necessary arrangements including the convening of an interviewing panel of members of the committee so that the necessary recommendation can made to the Council.

# <u>Finance</u>

6. The post of Independent Member is unpaid but an Independent Member is entitled to receive travelling expenses.

## <u>Law</u>

7. The appointment of Independent Members to a Standards Committee is governed by Section 56 of the Local Government Act 2000 and the Standards Committee (England) Regulations 2008. At least 25% of the membership of the Standards Committee must be independent members and their appointment must be confirmed by full Council.

## Equality Impact

8. The content of this report complies with the Council's policies on equality and diversity.

### **Recommendation**

9. That the Monitoring Officer be authorised to make all the necessary arrangements regarding the appointment of an Independent Member of the Council's Standards Committee with a view to the making of a recommendation to the Council on such an appointment for a four year period commencing on 27<sup>th</sup> April,2010.
