## West Midlands Average Speed Enforcement - Proposed Interim Agreement 2024/25

On 23<sup>rd</sup> January 2024, the following principles were negotiated by representatives of each Local Authority, the West Midlands Combined Authority and West Midlands Police to provide the approach for an interim agreement between partners for the financial year 2024-2025:

Agree to continue enforcement of Average Camera Offences in the spirit of the following agreements:

- Working Agreement: Relating to Average Speed Enforcement in Birmingham and Solihull
- Working Agreement: Relating to Average Speed Enforcement in Coventry
- Joint Working Agreement: Relating to Average Speed Enforcement across the **Black Country**

To meet or exceed the 'Benchmark Target' enforcement level within each of the 3 agreements.

To support the installation and enforcement of additional speed enforcement cameras to include those currently being progressed:

- Coventry Moseley Avenue, Wheelwright Lane and Tile Hill Lane
- Sandwell Hagley Road West (Wolverhampton Road to Quinton Expressway).
- Solihull Hampton, Meriden, Berkswell and Balsall Common
- Any other scheme with exceptional circumstances during this interim agreement can be considered on a case-by-case basis.

To support the exploration of opportunities for fixed cameras enabling enforcement of other endorsable offences that contribute towards KSI collisions.

It is agreed between all partners that no surplus or other funds will be returned to Local Authorities from WMP during the duration of the interim agreement. Any surplus funds generated by WMP during this period shall only be used to support Road Safety activity or initiatives.

To commit to working towards a replacement agreement for April 2025 onwards. These principles are not intended to be legally binding but are a joint commitment between all partners, negotiating in good faith in the spirit of partnership to safeguard the public from death and serious injury on our roads.
