Responses To Issues Raised at the Previous Meeting held on 23rd June 2010

Petitions

- a) A petition was submitted by resident, living in the locality of Ruiton Street, Lower Gornal, who wished for traffic calming measures to be put into place as soon as possible between the Five Ways Island and Stickley Lane. The Petition was referred to the Director of the Urban Environment for consideration.
- b) It was reported that a petition had been received by the Directorate of Adult Community and Housing Services in respect of the development of Wood Road garage site which was being investigated.

A number of issues arose from a presentation on Highways Minor Work Capital Programme for 2010/11.

The Group Engineer Traffic and Road Safety has advised that:

- a) Requests for pedestrian crossings near the shops on the Northway, at Gospel End Street and Ruiton Street and Summer Lane in the vicinity of the Five Ways Island would be assessed in the next financial year for possible inclusion in the Pedestrian Crossing Facility or Safer Routes to Schools Schemes as part of a future year's annual Capital Programme, providing that financial resources were available.
- b) That there were no proposals for pedestrian crossings in the North Dudley Area during the 2010/2011.
