## <u>Dedicated Schools Grant (DSG) Budget – Schools Budget - 2006/07 Financial Year Provisional Outturn</u>

#### **Purpose of Report**

1. To provide Schools Forum with the provisional outturn data in respect of the Schools Budget for the 2006/07 financial year.

### **Background**

- 2. The Schools Forum is responsible for the allocation of the Dedicated Schools Grant (DSG) for 2006/07.
- 3. For the 2006/07 financial year the DSG is £173.955m. The DSG funds the Schools Budget. The Schools Budget is a combination of centrally retained budgets together with the ISB (Individual Schools Budget).
- 4. The monitoring report in respect of the 2006/07 financial year was last presented to Schools Forum at the meeting in February 2007 at which time there was a forecasted overspend of £1.1m, however at the meeting in March 2007 is was estimated that, due to management action, this overspend had significantly reduced with the latest estimated overspend of £100k.
- 5. The Authority is now finalising the accounts for the year ended 31 March 2007; the Audit Commission will commence their external audit of the accounts during June. Therefore until this process is completed the financial outturn data for 2006/07 is reported as a provisional outturn.
- 6. The provisional outturn for 2006/07 is on budget at £173.955m; this includes a reserve of £129k earmarked in respect of Dudley primary schools reorganisation as detailed in the report Primary Schools Reorganisation, elsewhere on the agenda.
- 7. At the Schools Forum meeting in March 2007, it was necessary to earmark a sum of £100k from the 2007/08 DSG to cover the anticipated overspending in 2006/07. As this is no longer required for this purpose the £100k can be released and will be retained within the schools specific contingency awaiting a decision on its future use.

#### **Finance**

- 8. The funding of schools is prescribed by the DfES through the School Finance (England) Regulations 2007
- 9. From 1<sup>st</sup> April 2006, the Schools Budget is funded by a direct DfES grant: Dedicated School Grant (DSG).

#### <u>Law</u>

10. Councils' LMS Schemes are made under Section 48 of the School Standards and Framework Act 1998. The Education Acts 1996 and 2002 also have provisions relating to school funding.

#### **Equality Impact**

11. The Council's Equal Opportunities Policy is taken into account when considering the allocation of resources.

#### **Recommendation**

12. Schools Forum to note that, subject to the external audit during June 2007, the 2006/07 outturn in respect of the DSG (Dedicated Schools Grant) will be in balance, which will release the £100k contingency approved for 2007/08.
