24 **APPLICATION FOR LICENSED PREMISES GAMING MACHINE PERMIT - THE FOLEY ARMS, 309 HAGLEY ROAD, PEDMORE, STOURBRIDGE**

A report of the Interim Director of Law and Property was submitted on further consideration to be given to the application made for the grant of a Licensed Premises Gaming Machine Permit for three machines in respect of the Foley Arms, 309 Hagley Road, Pedmore, in the light of the decision of the Sub-Committee made at its meeting held on the 16th December, 2008, to refuse the application on the grounds that the proposed site of the third Category C Gaming Machine would not be in full and observed view of the whole bar at the premises.

Arising from this decision, a request had been made by the Solicitors involved asking that the Sub-Committee undertake a site visit and give further consideration to the application.

Prior to this meeting, a site visit had been made to the Foley Arms and agreement reached with the designated premises supervisor on the siting of the third Category C Gaming Machine. The location of that machine had been marked on a plan for the purpose and would be located at the current location of a cigarette machine in the premises, again as indicated on the plan used for identification purposes.

During the site visit, it was also noted that one of the existing gaming machines was not visible from the bar.

RESOLVED

That, following the site visit made and the further consideration given to the current application, a further application be requested from Poppleston Allen, Solicitors, in respect of the Foley Arms for the grant of a Licensed Premises Gaming Machine Permit for three machines, arising from the agreed positioning of the third Category C Games Machine, as indicated on the plan used for identification purposes at the site visit held, and that the determination of that application be delegated to the Interim Director of Law and Property.
