GRANT OF STREET COLLECTION PERMIT

1.0 PURPOSE

1.1 To consider the application on behalf of Joanna Condon of Dialogue Direct Limited for the grant of a Street Collection Permit on behalf of Shelter.

2.0 BACKGROUND

- 2.1 On the 18th March 2005, Joanna Condon, of Dialogue Direct Limited made application for the grant of a Street Collection's Permit on behalf of Shelter. A copy of that application form is attached to this report as appendix 1.
- 2.2 That application was circulated to the West Midlands Police and the Director of the Urban Environment; no objections were raised to the application.
- 2.3. In January 1999, the Licensing Section in accordance with the neighbouring Authorities Working Group introduced a Policy requiring all street collection applications to submit income and expenditure accounts for the previous financial year. The accounts are attached to this report as appendix 2.

3.1 That the Committee consider the application for a street collection permit in respect of Dialogue Direct Limited on behalf of Shelter.
